











According to Pew Research Center, Buddhists are projected to maintain in numbers (0.49b) but decrease in % of global population (7.1% to 5.2%).

Other studies suggest taking 40% as a median for China's Buddhist population, giving us a total of 1.09b Buddhist population globally or 15.6% of world population

Projected Change in Global Population

With the exception of Buddhists, all of the major religious groups are expected to increase in number by 2050. But some will not keep pace with global population growth, and, as a result, are expected to make up a smaller percentage of the world's population in 2050 than they did in 2010.


